## NORTHEAST-10 CO-OFFENSIVE PLAYERS OF THE WEEK



**Jeremiah Watts, Merrimack** (Sr., WR, Clovis, Calif.) - Set the school-record and Northeast-10 record with 19 receptions in a game, tallying 212 receiving yards and a touchdown in a 52-42 win over Southern Connecticut.



**Ryan Osiecki, New Haven** (So., QB, Seymour, Conn.) - Led the Chargers in a 47-43 victory in their NE-10 season finale at Saint Anselm. Helped mark the Chargers down the field in the final minutes on a game-winning drive, including a 32-yard touchdown pass to give New Haven the final lead of the game. Finished the game with 362 yards, five touchdowns and no interceptions on 25-of-40 passing. Sacked just twice and threw a game-long 54-yard touchdown in the fourth quarter.

## NORTHEAST-10 DEFENSIVE PLAYER AND FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK



**Jareed Gaines, Stonehill** (Fr., DB, Lumberton, N.J.) - Led a Stonehill defense that held the NE-10's top scoring offense at the time to just 14 points, and one of its top rushers to only 46 yards, in Friday's 22-14 victory at Assumption. Totaled ten tackles (nine solo), including 3.0 tackles for a loss of seven yards, a sack, forced fumble, fumble return, pass breakup, blocked kick and two quarterback hurries. With the Skyawks leading 15-14 and Assumption with a first and ten at the Stonehill 27, Gaines forced a fumble on the Greyhounds quarterback and returned it 73-yards for a game-clinching touchdown with 33-seconds to play. Blocked a 35-yard field goal try in the fourth quarter after on Assumption's drive after Stonehill had taken a 15-14 lead.

## 2009 NORTHEAST-10 FOOTBALL WEEKLY INFORMATION



**AMERICAN INTERNATIONAL:** AIC dropped a 20-9 decision at Pace, giving the Setters their first win of the season. Senior Shane Murphy completed 17-of-36 passes for 137 yards and was intercepted twice in the game. He now ranks 10th on the career passing list with 2,601 career passing yards, surpassing Ken Eldridge (2,517 yards, 1964-66) on the career list. He needs just 43 yards to pass Terry Wallis (1983-85) total of 2,643 passing yards to move into ninth. Senior wide receiver Kertis Hussey (Paterson, N.J.) caught seven passes for 69 yards, both game-highs. He now ranks second on the career receptions list with 155, surpassing Dan Grant's 154 career receptions from 1996-99.



**ASSUMPTION:** The Greyhounds broke their season record for points and now have scored 275 points breaking the old mark of 265 set in 11 games in 2000. Senior middle linebacker Dustin Zitzmann (Pinellas Park, Fla.) now has 153-251--404 career tackles just behind current leader Bill Guilfoil (1990, 92-94), who finished with 275-134-409. He has had seven games with 10-or-more tackles this season with 20 his high mark (Southern Connecticut). Wide receiver David Canney (Templeton, Mass.) has 51 receptions for 688 yards and seven touchdowns this season and in his career has 145 receptions for 1,876 yards and 13 touchdowns. Only Canney and Jake Beers (2004-07) have had two 50-reception seasons (Canney had 62 in 2007). With 145 career catches he trails only Beers (158) on the all-time list and he is one of three with two 600-yard receiving years (Mauer and Beers). His 1,876 career yards trails only Beers (1,950) and Mauer (2,166). Junior running back Herbert Woodard scored his 17th touchdown of the season vs. Stonehill and became the first Hound with over 100 points (102) in a single season and is now the career scoring leader with 210 points.



**BENTLEY:** Bentley had a bye week, but was assured of at least a share of the Northeast-10 Conference championship when Merrimack College, the team responsible for the Falcons' only loss, upended Southern Connecticut, 52-42. Coach Thom Boerman's club, 8-1 overall and number five in the Oct. 26 NCAA Division II Super Regional One rankings, can wrap up its first outright title since 2003 with a victory at Stonehill Saturday. Bentley cracked the AFCA Division II top 25 last week for the first time since 2004, which was also the last time the Falcons had a piece of the conference championship.



**MERRIMACK:** Merrimack remained alive for a share of the Northeast-10 Conference title with a 52-42 win over Southern Connecticut. The Warriors must beat Pace, coupled with a Bentley loss to Stonehill to earn a share of the title. Jeremiah Watts (Clovis, CA) set a school record with 19 catches in the win. Sophomore linebacker Shawn Loiseau (Shrewsbury, Mass.) picked up 10 tackles, breaking the school record of 105 set in 1999. With one regular season game remaining, Loiseau has 111 tackles and leads the conference in tackles per game. Led by 467 total yards by James Suozzo (Everett, Mass.), the Warriors racked up 619 yards (364 passing, 255 rushing), which rank second all-time in school history. They had 36 first downs, setting a school record. Freshman Jimon Hill (North Chicago, Ill.) recorded his first 100-yard game, rushing for 139 yards on 24 carries. The Warriors also set the school-record for total yards in a season with 4,318, surpassing last year's total of 4,234. Chris Laham (Westwood, Mass.) added two more touchdown receptions to his school-record of 36.



**NEW HAVEN:** The Chargers rallied by scoring 20 points in the fourth quarter, including 13 in the final five minutes to even their NE-10 record at 4-4 with a 47-43 victory at Saint Anselm College on Saturday. The Chargers were faced with a fourth-and-one with 1:13 remaining in the fourth quarter when Kameel Lashley caught a pass and took it 32-yards for a touchdown to give UNH their only lead of the game. Offensively, New Haven was led by quarterback Ryan Osiecki. The Seymour, Conn. native threw for 362 yards and five touchdowns on 25-of-40 passing. Sharieff Hall was his favorite receiver with eight catches for 140 yards and two touchdowns. Demetrius Washington-Ellison and Jason Thomp-

son also grabbed touchdown passes. The Chargers first 100-yard rusher of the season, Josh Smart ran for 151 yards and one touchdown on 18 carries. The Charger defense was led by Moses White with 12 total tackles, while Tom Herd added eight tackles, a sack and a team-high three pass break ups. The Chargers return to action on Saturday in their 2009 season finale against Ohio Dominican at DellaCamera Stadium. Kickoff is set for 12 p.m.



**PACE:** The Setters snapped a three-game losing streak to American International with a 20-9 victory on Saturday. Pace posted their second victory against Yellow Jackets in 13 meetings with their only other win coming in 2005 when the Setters won 20-7. Junior running back Jason Washington led the Setters to the win with 110 yards on the ground along with two touchdowns.



**SAINT ANSELM:** Saint Anselm dropped a 47-43 final to New Haven on Saturday afternoon at Grappone Stadium. Prior to the game, the team observed a moment of silence in honor of former quarterback Kyle Van De Giesen '02, who was killed in Afghanistan last week while serving his country. Marine Captain Van De Giesen was the Hawks' quarterback in the 1999 season, the first varsity season for the program after a 58-year hiatus. In the loss to New Haven, freshman quarterback Michael Pierce broke his own single-game school record as he threw for 397 yards to go along with three touchdowns. He also added 64 yards on the ground for 461 yards of total offense. Pierce now has the top three games in school history for total offensive yards with 496, 461 and 422. Freshman wide receiver Joe Robichaud pulled down a season-high nine passes for 131 yards and one touchdown, while sophomore Marc Wilson had 13 catches for 89 yards and a score. Wilson now has 74 catches on the season, a school record for the season. Senior All-America candidate Dan Bohenek had a team-best 13 tackles and now has 273 for his career, ranking him second on the all-time Saint Anselm list. The team concludes the 2009 season on Saturday as the Hawks host Southern Connecticut for a Noon start at Grappone Stadium. Prior to the game, this year's Senior Class will be recognized for their contributions to the Saint Anselm football program throughout their careers.



**SOUTHERN CONNECTICUT:** The Owls dropped their second NE-10 game of the year on Friday night in a high-scoring 52-42 decision against Merrimack. Andre Privott (Middletown, Conn.) had six catches for 116 yards in the contest. The Owls honored their 13 seniors before the game. Rashaad Slowley (Mt. Vernon, N.Y.) posted his third 100-yard game of the year, rushing for exactly 100 yards on just nine carries.



**STONEHILL:** Stonehill picked up its second-straight win with a dramatic 22-14 win at Assumption on Friday night. The Skyhawks close out their season this Saturday when it hosts rival Bentley University for Senior Day on Family Weekend at noon. Freshman Jared Gaines (Lumberton, N.J.) filled the defensive stat sheet with ten tackles (nine solo), three for a loss of seven yards, a sack, forced fumble, fumble return, pass break up, blocked kick and two quarterback hurries. His 73-yard fumble return for touchdown with under a minute to play sealed the win and marked his second fumble return for a touchdown this season. Freshman Kevin Anderson (Topsfield, Mass.) collected three interceptions at Assumption and now leads the NE-10 with 13 passes defended this season. Junior running back Eddie Vachon (Newton, Mass.) posted a career-best 69-yard touchdown run in the first quarter and finished with 124 yards on eight carries (15.5/rush) marking the first time a Stonehill player has rushed for over 100 yards in consecutive games since 2000. Vachon moved into second place on Stonehill's career list with 3,073 all-purpose yards, passing three former Skyhawks with his 151 yards Friday night. He is now just 38 yards shy of Mike McSharry's career record of 3,111 set from 1995-97. Senior Brendan Gorey (West Islip, N.Y.) booted a career-best 45-yard field goal to give Stonehill a 15-14 fourth quarter lead at Assumption on Friday night.
