## 2009 NORTHEAST-10 FOOTBALL WEEKLY INFORMATION



**AMERICAN INTERNATIONAL:** AIC improved to 3-0 with a 35-17 win at Stonehill, marking just the eighth time in the program's 73-season history that it has opened the year with three straight wins. Senior wide receiver Kertis Hussey caught five passes for 73 yards and on TD. He now ranks third on AIC's career receptions list (123) and is up to eighth on the career receiving yardage list (1,718). The victory over the Skyhawks was the 98th career win for head coach Art Wilkins, who is in 16th season at AIC.



**ASSUMPTION:** Senior middle linebacker Dustin Zitzmann (Pinellas Park, Fla.) had 4-8--12 tackles, a fumble recovery, a pass breakup and a pass pressure in the win over New Haven. He now has 122 212--334 career tackles --- fourth on the Greyhounds' career list. Junior running back Herbert Woodard (Bridgeton, N.J.) now has nine 100-yard games and three straight to open this season. He has 413 yards on 64 carries and eight touchdowns averaging 6.5 yards/carry and 137.7 yards/game and in his career he now has 377 carries for 1,929 yards and 22 touchdowns (156 points). His 377 carries and 1,929 yards are now second all-time for the Greyhounds to Fran DeFalco (1992-94) (398-2,289). Junior wide receiver David Canney (Templeton, Mass.) now has 105 receptions (fourth in Hounds list) 1,381 yards (third) in his career. The Greyhounds are off this week before hosting Southern Connecticut (September 26) at Fall Homecoming.



**BENTLEY:** Bentley's 24-0 win over Saint Anselm Friday night marked the Falcons' first shutout since a 42-0 victory over Bryant Oct. 29, 2004, and gave coach Thom Boerman's team its first 3-0 record since the 2003 team won its first 10. The Falcons held the Hawks to 125 yards total offense, including minus-34 net rushing yards, and limited Saint Anselm to four or less plays on 13 of 17 possessions. Senior RB Luis Cotto (Waltham, Mass.) topped the 2,000 mark in career all-purpose yards, becoming the 20th player in the program's history to achieve that feat. On Saturday, Bentley will travel to New Haven for the Chargers' first home game since 2003. That game will kick off the conference's series of 'Packcasts' and can be seen online at [www.northeast10.org](http://www.northeast10.org).



**MERRIMACK:** Merrimack earned its first win of the season, defeating Husson University 23-0 Saturday at a rainy Warrior Field. Anthony Smalls (Dorchester, Mass.) rushed for a career-high 188 yards, including 154 in the first half on 15 carries. Chris Laham (Westwood, Mass.) tied Calvin Bryant for the school record for career touchdowns with 28, with a 56-yard touchdown reception in the first quarter. Jason Fischer (South Hereford, Md.) picked off two passes, the first two of his career in the win. The 23-0 win marked the first shutout since Merrimack blanked Pace 31-0 on October 27, 2007. The Warriors conclude a season-opening three-game homestand and open the conference schedule against Stonehill College Friday at 7 p.m.



**NEW HAVEN:** The New Haven football team fell 31-10 Friday night to Assumption College. The Charger offense tallied over 300 yards, but two fumbles in the redzone proved to be too much for the Chargers to overcome. Quarterback Ryan Osiecki led the team with 348 yards passing and one touchdown on 32-of-54 passing. The Chargers host their first home game since 2003 on Saturday when Bentley travels to West Haven, Conn. The game will be also kickoff the Northeast-10 Conference 'PackCasts' schedule, featuring free live webcasts online.



**PACE:** The Setters fell to Southern Connecticut 27-10 in the team's conference opener. Greg Brain led the Setter defense with 15 total tackles, while Andrew Lipski posted 12 tackles. Red-shirt freshman quarterback Joe Romanick tossed a 41-yard touchdown pass to junior receiver Eric Ortega in the fourth quarter for the Setters' lone touchdown of the game. Pace will look get into the win column this week as the Setters will host Saint Anselm College on Saturday in the Setters home opener at 12 pm.



**SAINT ANSELM:** The Saint Anselm football team dropped to 1-2 overall on the season on Friday night as the Hawks fell to Bentley by a 24-0 final. The Hawks had difficulty moving the ball in the wind-driven rain, but still trailed by only a 9-0 margin at the half. Freshman quarterback Michael Pierce finished with 18 completions for 159 yards and moved the ball offensively in the third quarter as the rain subsided briefly. The leading receiver for the Hawks was freshman Craig Dennis, who pulled down six passes for a season-best 61 yards. Defensively, All-America candidate Dan Bohenek led the team with 12 tackles, including two tackles for a loss and one forced fumble. Chris Bent posted a career-high 11 tackles and had one fumble recovery. Bohenek is tied for the league lead in tackles per game, while Bent is the leading freshman tackler in the league. The Hawks hit the road on Saturday, September 19th as the team travels to Pace for a Noon start. The Hawks defeated the Setters by a 28-14 score in the 2008 season finale in Pleasantville.



**SOUTHERN CONNECTICUT:** The Owls won their first game of the year on Friday, a 27-10 triumph over Pace. Southern Connecticut had two running backs break the 100-yard mark in the contest. Senior Jarom Freeman (Peekskill, N.Y.) finished with 113 yards and a touchdown, while sophomore Rashaad Slowley (Mount Vernon, N.Y.) registered 122 yards. It was Slowley's first collegiate effort with at least 100 yards on the ground. The Owls' defense posted eight sacks in the win over Pace, including two each from reigning Defensive Player of the Year Jerome Pinckney (Norcross, Ga.) and Daniel Allen (Bridgeport, Conn.).



**STONEHILL:** Junior running back Eddie Vachon (Newton, Mass.) moved into sixth place on Stonehill's all-time list as his 55-yards rushing give him 1,310 career yards. Senior placekicker Brandon Gorey (West Islip, N.Y.) remains perfect on kicks this season after drilling a 38-yarder through the rain to spark Stonehill's comeback against Assumption. He is now 10-for-10 this year on extra points and 2-for-2 on field goals. Sophomore Stephan Neville (Foxborough, Mass.) finished with 100-plus yards on kick returns for the second-straight year with his 101 yards on two returns on Friday night. He also led the defense with 11 tackses (eight solo).
