**Johannah Leedham, Franklin Pierce** (So., F, Ellesmere Port, England) - Averaged 18 points, six rebounds, 3.5 assists and 3.5 steals in a 2-0 week. Shot 61.9-percent (13-for-21) from the field and converted 10-of-14 (71.4%) free-throw attempts for the week. Scored 23 points (7-12 FGs, 9-13 FTs) and recorded five rebounds and four steals in the win over Southern New Hampshire. Totaled 13 points (6-9 FGs), seven rebounds, six assists and three steals in just 17 minutes of action in a win at Post.

Led Franklin Pierce past Post with 24 points (11-14 FGs, 2-4 3s), four rebounds, three assists and three steals. Posted nine points and six assists in win at Southern New Hampshire.

**Courtney Coryea, Le Moyne** (So., F, Mooers Forks, N.Y.) - Had 17 points in an 63-60 overtime victory over American International. Shot 5-of-10 from the field and 7-of-8 from the free throw line. Also added six rebounds, four assists, two blocks and one steal.

**Kara Borelli, Merrimack** (Sr., F, Westbrook, Maine) - Averaged 12 points and 7.5 rebounds in two games this past week. Recorded a double-double (16 points, 11 rebounds) while making all 11 free throws at Bentley.

Scored 16 points, collected two rebounds, dished out two assists and recorded two steals against Merrimack. Scored 17 points and added five rebounds and handed out three assists against Clayton State.
